






FALL 'BIBLE STUDY' AN-NOUNCED.

FALL LEAF COLLECTION

The only question we receive more often than what night is Trick or Treat is when will my leaves be collected. The leaf collection schedule is determined by the weather and crews will begin collecting leaves at the curb when the majority of the leaves have fallen. Collection will begin on streets that are designated as Snow Emergency Routes and then crews will move onto side

streets. Leaves should not be raked into the roadway and residents can take their leaves to the Borough's Thomas Avenue Drop-Off Center during hours of operation which include Mondays & Wednesdays between 4:00pm and 7:00pm and Saturdays, between 8:00am and 3:00pm.



WINTER WEATHER INFORMATION

It might be too early to think about snow in October but

winter will be here before we know it, and the residents are reminded a Snow Emergency automatically goes into effect in Sayre Borough when the National Weather Service issues a Winter Storm Warning or Heavy Snow Warning for our area. During a Snow Emergency residents are required to remove their vehicles from streets designated as Snow Emergency Routes for the duration of the Snow Emergency. The Snow Emergency is cancelled after the Winter Storm Warning expires. The Borough may decide to extend the Snow Emergency if necessary. Vehicles that remain on designated Snow Emergency Routes will be ticketed and/or towed. Residents are encouraged to monitor local media outlets for information during winter storms and frequently check the Borough's Facebook page for updates and postponements

Grass clippings, brush, and other yard waste can be taken to the Thomas Avenue Recycling & Compost Facility on Mondays and Wednesday between 4:00pm & 7:00pm and on Saturdays between 8:00am & 3:00pm.




