New Business:

- Bruce presented changes to the 2025 draft budget (primarily based on actuals through 11/30/24). Also, a three percent raise is included for Jerry, Maria, and Marcella. Motion to approve the 2025 Budget made by Betsy, seconded by Jeff. Motion carries.
- Discussion on potential candidates for Vestry. Betsy and Jeff end their terms and Diane is eligible for re-election.
- Our Annual Meeting is scheduled for Sunday, January 26, 2025 at 12:00 pm. This will include a potluck lunch. Snow date will be February 2, 2025.
- The bulk of the January Vestry meeting will be devoted to the Conklin Trust.
- A Plaque honoring Linda Murrelle for her years of service preparing and serving meals for the Community Supper will be presented at the upcoming Annual Meeting. Alice is planning on getting the Plaque.
- On our To Do list for 2025 is to prepare a list of Donors for the Stained Glass Window Project.
- Christmas gifts for Jerry, Maria, and Marcella will be a Gift Card.

Highlights:

- The Capital Campaign for the Stained Glass Window Project is completed. All pledges have been received in full. All of the windows have not been adopted and that's okay.
- Our Diocesan Loan continues with a 3 percent interest rate.
- Our 2025 Pledge Campaign "Walk in Love": Twenty pledge cards have been returned thus far. We expect that about 30% of our pledges will come from those who did not complete a pledge card.

Rector's Report:

• On my mind:

In the same way that Betsy has a near lifelong commitment to Sunday School and VBS, Jeff is head of Building and Grounds for at least as long as I am rector.

I will be away at a retreat 12/13-12/15. Prayers will be led by Alice on 12/15 and there will be no communion that day.

Sunday School will have a Play 12/22 at 9:30 am. All are invited. Greening of the church will occur after worship on 12/22. Breakfast pizza and cookies/coffee will be provided and all are welcome to join us in preparing the church for the Christmas season.

We are not having an Angel Tree this year. Opportunities to participate are Angel Trees at the Hospital, Athens and Sayre Libraries. The Sayre Salvation Army Toy Drive is on 12/14 outside the Sayre Theatre and contributions are encouraged.
