We ask for your prayers for Kim and her family. Her father had emergency surgery this past Monday and will require some serious recovery time. He is the primary caregiver for Kim's mother who has serious health issues herself, so Kim and her sisters are in the midst of determining how best to care for both parents. They live several hours away from the valley. Kim is estimating that she will not be able to handle the Helping Hands phone for at least four weeks.

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




